The internship is seeking to train remarkable students to become leaders in innovative, pre-disaster, resiliency design strategies. The selected intern(s) will be given the opportunity to participate in projects that are making our nation's cities more resilient. AECOM will provide exposure to leading practices and practitioners in the field relevant to the intern's area of study.

ELIGIBILITY & LOCATION

The internship is open to full-time undergraduate and graduate students with research experience or training in areas including, but not limited to: urban planning, landscape architecture, urban design, engineering, water resources, resilient design, and/or coastal flooding adaptation strategies. Applying students should have a background in planning, design, civil and environmental engineering, or a related field (required qualification – at a minimum applicants should be pursuing a bachelor degree in one of these academic areas). The selected intern will work at AECOM's Arlington, VA office.

The internship partners are committed to building inclusive research, extension, communication and education programs that serve people with diverse backgrounds, circumstances, needs, perspectives, and ways of thinking. Diversity includes, but is not limited to, age, race, ethnicity, nationality, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability and/or health status, religion, veteran status, geographic origin and socio-economic status. Applicants enrolled at a Virginia institution and those with prior internship experience are encouraged to apply.
