# eSeaGrant Instructions

**Application Deadline to VASG: February 18, 2022**

### OVERVIEW

If you plan to apply, VASG strongly recommends registering for eSeaGrant at least two weeks in advance of the application deadline. Please review the 2023 National Sea Grant College Program Dean John A. Knauss Marine Policy Fellowship Notice of Funding Opportunity (<https://vaseagrant.org/wp-content/uploads/NOAA-OAR-SG-2023-2007040-NOFO-Report.pdf>) and refer to these instructions as a guide to submit your application using eSeaGrant. Virginia applicants are strongly encouraged to contact VASG at least one to two months prior to the state application deadline to receive application support and provide notification of your intent to apply.

### CREATING YOUR ESEAGRANT ACCOUNT

Applicants can create an eSeaGrant account by visiting the website (<http://vaseagrant.ecsion.com>), selecting the "Register" tab, and completing the required information. If you do not receive a "welcome" email with login credentials shortly after creating an account, please contact VASG using the email address below. Once you log in, you can change your password and updated your profile. To do so, click your name in the upper-right corner of the screen, and select "My Profile."

### CREATING A FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

To start an application, or edit an existing application, click on "Current Tasks" on the banner head, and select "Add Proposal" under "2023 Knauss Marine Policy Fellowship."

Once you have added the fellowship application to your Current Tasks, progress down through the sequence of application sections ("2023 Knauss - Curriculum Vitae" through "Submission Preview") listed on the left side of the window to complete and submit your application. Guidance related to each individual form follows, in sequence. Please note - some sections may require additional pop-up pages. Please allow your browser to display pop-up windows and enable JavaScript.

eSeaGrant provides sections to upload your personal education and career development response, relevant coursework and future year plans, and undergraduate and graduate transcripts. These documents must be converted to PDFs. To preserve confidentiality, letters of recommendation must be uploaded directly from the referees to VASG through eSeaGrant. Applicants must identify and submit requests to their referees through eSeaGrant by entering their referees' names and email addresses in the corresponding section.
